"Offended" (Skandalizō {skan-dal-id'-zo}...
involves not so much setting a trap, although that
may be part of the term; instead, it concerns 'causing
offense, causing stumbling.' Stumbling directly
corresponds to a relationship with God.



John 16:7-14

The gospel message does one of two things:

(1) men and women repent and are saved; or

(2) men and women stumble and perish.



John 16:7-14

"expedient" ... profitable, advantageous refers to the ultimate good and not necessarily the good of the present situation (CBL)

(decision, verdict, damnation, condemnation)


## II. The Holy Spirit Guides

- 3. Quenching (suppress, stiffle) 1 Thess. 5:19

1<sup>st</sup> ... to praise or pay honor to someone;
2<sup>nd</sup> ... to adorn or clothe with glory,
splendor, or luster,

... celebrating the value or nature of someone or something.
